

Calls to Action:

As communities continue to push for affirmative relief and a path to citizenship, we also need urgent action to end deportations, shut downmovement.

- **Get Involved with Detention Center Visitation (ICDI Program):** ICDI conducts jail visitation to those who are currently detained in Illinois. www.icdichicago.org/volunteer
 - **Volunteer for virtual detention center visitations** (For Spanish Speakers) You will be paired up with someone who is detained and meet with them virtually for 1 hr per week.
 - Write letters to those who are detained Letters in English and Spanish will be sent to those who are detained to let them know we are thinking of them and care about them.
 - **Donate for Commissary** People who are detained need to pay for basic necessities. Commissary allows them to pay for hygienic items such as soap and shampoo, and to make calls to their loved ones, family members, and lawyers.
- Encourage others to support immigrant rights: sign the petition by the Detention Watch Network's National Day of Action. There are also ongoing opportunities to call/email/tweet representatives to advocate for the end of detention and deportations.
